PORTALS OF PRAYER for January-March are available on the Guest Book table in the narthex.

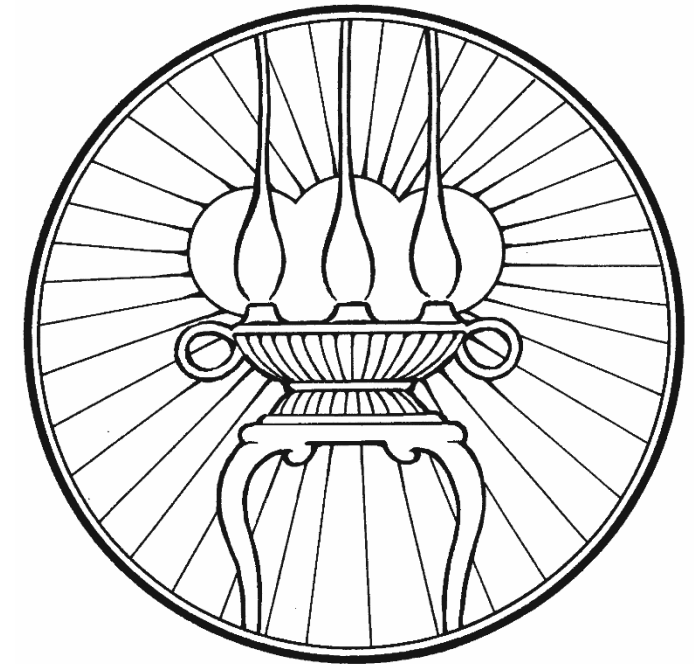
