PORTALS OF PRAYER for July-September are available on the guest book table in the narthex. Take one for your family devotions, or take one to a friend.

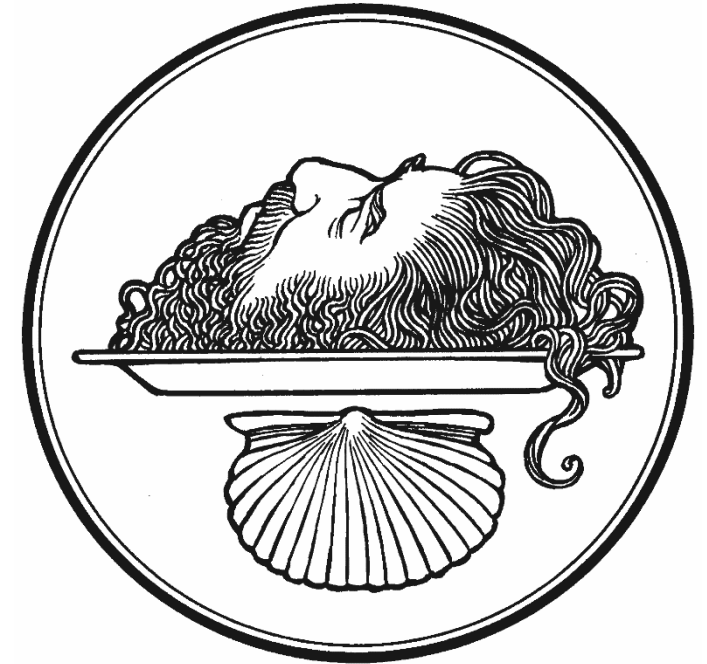
