The pro-abortion ballot initiative 439, "Protect Our Rights," would legalize abortion until birth, subject preborn children to painful late term dismemberment abortions, and eliminate parental notification requirements. The pro-life ballot initiative 434, "Protect Women & Children," asserts that life is a human right, and women, children, and families in Nebraska deserve real love and support, not dangerous proposals that jeopardize the health and safety of women and end the lives of precious baby boys and girls. The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod believes that abortion is contrary to God's Word and is not a moral option.
