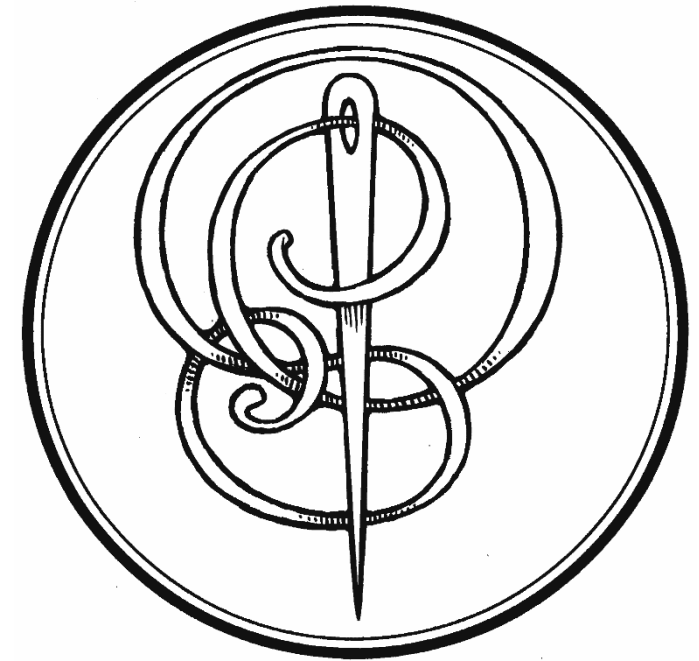
PORTALS OF PRAYER for Oct-Dec are available on the Guest Book table in the narthex.
