ANNIVERSARY ORNAMENTS: The ornaments have been delivered, and there are extras to purchase. Please see Rachel Hrabik.

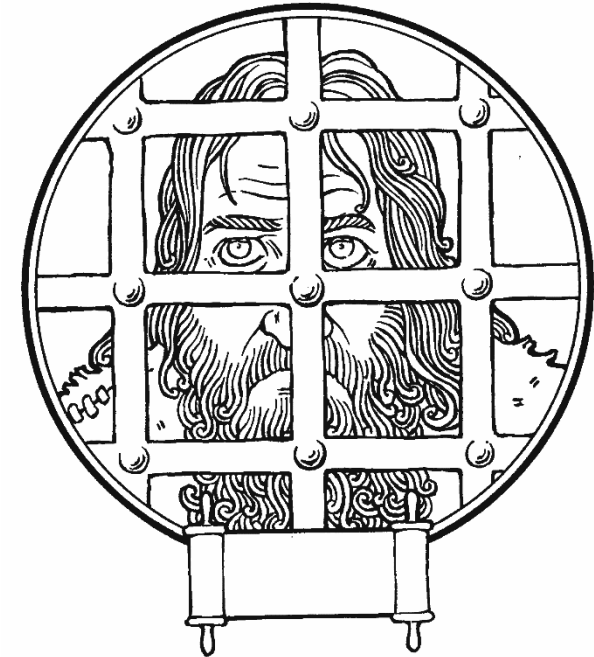
