EAGLE FOOD BANK: LWML continues to collect food for the Eagle food bank. Donations can be left in the tote by the church entrance. Thank you for your donations!

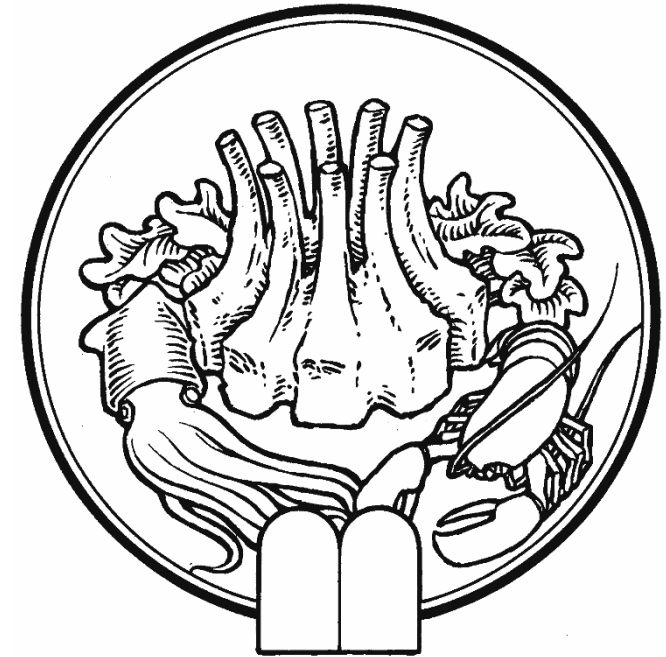
PORTALS OF PRAYER for July-September are available on the Guest Book table in the narthex.
