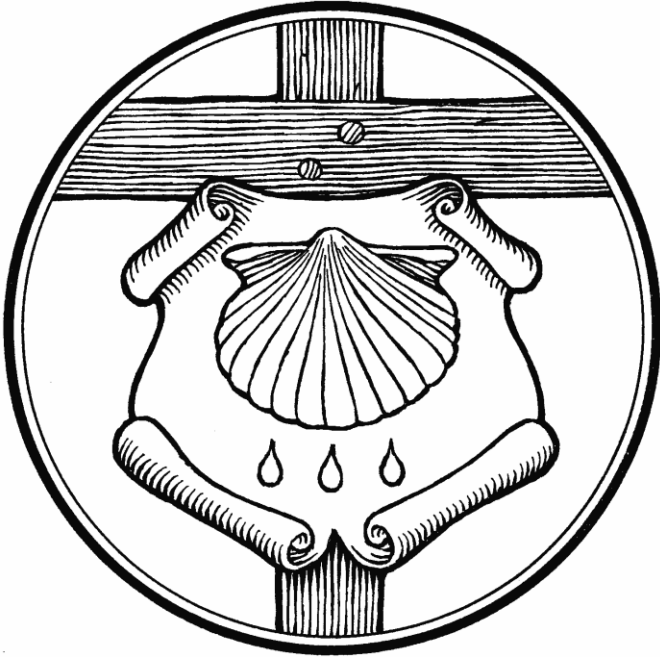

The Great Vigil of Easter is a celebration of the “Pascha” ~ the death and resurrection of our Lord. The Vigil, which began last night with the Services of Light, Readings, and Holy Baptism ~ continues now with the Services of Prayer, the Word, and the Sacrament.

P: Who appeared to Peter and to the Twelve, to over 500 disciples, to James and to all the apostles, and to Paul on the Damascus road,

**C: Have mercy on us.**

P: Who commissioned Your Church to make disciples of all nations by baptizing and teaching them,

**C: Have mercy on us.**

P: By Your glorious resurrection from the dead,

**C: Good Lord, deliver us.**

P: By Your victory over sin and death,

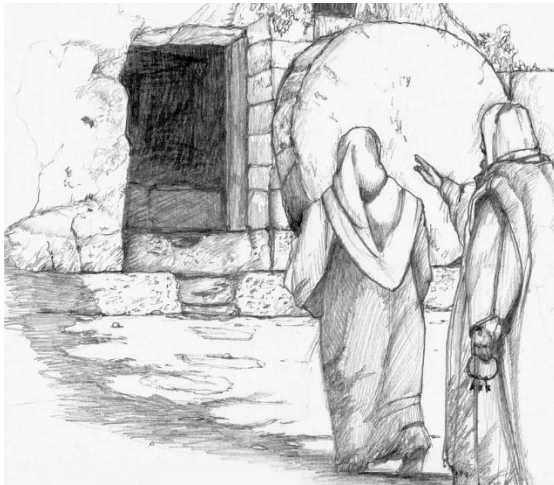
