<u>Season of the Church Year ~ Easter</u>: Today (May 3rd) is the Fourth Sunday of Easter. The Season of Easter consists of the fifty days leading from the Resurrection of Our Lord to the Feast of Pentecost.

Daily Prayer For Individuals and Families can be found at LSB 294-298.

Hymns or Canticles for this week: LSB 709, 602, 740.

<u>Psalms</u>: Use the psalms for Easter in the chart at LSB 304. The psalms are found in the front of the hymnal (LSB 1-150).

Scripture Readings: The Daily Lectionary for Holy Week can be found at LSB 300 (Easter 4).

<u>Small Catechism (LSB 321-330)</u>: Suggestions for this week include: The Third Commandment and meaning; the First Article of the Creed and meaning; the Introduction and Sixth Petition of the Lord's Prayer and their meanings; and the fourth part of the Sacrament of Holy Baptism.

Apostles' Creed & Lord's Prayer can be found on the inside back cover of LSB.

<u>Prayers</u>: Ask for family prayer requests. You may make use of the prayers in LSB (305-318). Also take note of the framework for prayer emphasis for each day of the week at LSB 294.
