HOLY TRIDUUM: "Three Holy Days"

Throughout the Season of Lent we heard the call to "prepare with joy for the paschal feast." The time of the Lenten preparation has ended, and the time of celebration has begun. Today we begin what is known in the historic Christian Church as the Holy Triduum, a three day celebration of the Lord's Pasch, or Passover. These three days (from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Day) are a celebration of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ our Lord. The services of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday were conceived of as a single service of congregational worship, separated by times of "recess." Therefore, the Benediction which normally ends our service is omitted this evening.
